

**Government of Tamil Nadu Strengthens Forest Protection through Notification of New Reserve Forests.**

*The Government of Tamil Nadu has been methodical and steadfast in its resolve to bring more ecologically significant areas under the category of Reserve Forests, ensuring long-term conservation of the State's natural heritage.*

*As per the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882, the process begins with a proclamation under Section 4, notifying the intention to constitute an area as a Reserve Forest. This is followed by a detailed settlement process carried out by the Forest Settlement Officer. Upon completion of this statutory procedure, a final notification under Section 16 of the Act is issued, after which the notified area legally attains the status of a Reserve Forest in all respects. From this stage onwards, all non-forestry activities are prohibited.*

*Such notifications play a critical role in preserving the ecological character of forests and in safeguarding the flora and fauna specific to each landscape.*


*Demonstrating leadership in forest conservation, Tamil Nadu has, from 2021 till November 2025, notified 100 new Reserve Forests under Section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882. These notifications cover a total extent of 13,494.95.16 hectares, spread across the districts of Dindigul, Dharmapuri, Madurai, Kallakurichi, Theni, Sivagangai, Namakkal, Nilgiris, Salem, and Tenkasi.*

*Once an area is notified as a Reserve Forest, the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 become applicable, conferring the highest level of legal protection to forests recorded in Government records.*

*Through these sustained efforts, the Government of Tamil Nadu continues to reinforce its commitment for conserving forests, protecting biodiversity and securing ecological stability for future generations.*



## DINDIGUL DISTRICT



Dindigul District situated in central Tamil Nadu, Dindigul is home to the iconic Dindigul Fort (Dindigul Malai Kottai), a major tourist landmark. The district is known for its traditional lock-making and leather industries and has a thriving handloom sector. Kodaikanal, one of Tamil Nadu's most popular hill stations, is also located in Dindigul.


## TENKASI DISTRICT




